



Elder Abuse DVD Available Now

New Training Requirements for Illinois Financial Institutions

Public Act 96-1103 amended The Elder Abuse and Neglect Act. Financial institutions officers and employees who interact with older persons (defined as a resident of Illinois 60 years or older) are now required to have at **least 30 minutes of training** and refresher training every three years. Training for existing employees must be completed by February 1, 2012. The training course must address:

- recognizing the indicators of financial exploitation; and
- how to report financial exploitation of older adults.

The Illinois League of Financial Institutions has developed a DVD for training in elder abuse and neglect and a palm card that employees can post at their work stations to remind them of this training.

The cost of the DVD is \$185 for Illinois League member thrifts/banks. The cost for non-members is \$235. In either case, you only need to purchase one per institution. To order, please fill out the following information.
